Upon returning to school, students will:

- View their new timetable.
- Receive important information for the term
- Be in full, correct uniform.
- Be prepared for learning with a full set of equipment.
- Have completed their holiday homework, which will be reviewed on the first day back.
- Review all the HSAEL routines and rules that are in place to help them make progress.

Staff will complete a full uniform and equipment check. Please give your support to this by ensuring your child has the correct equipment and is in full Academy uniform. We will contact parents for any uniform or equipment snagging issues and students with incorrect uniform may not enter circulation until these are rectified. We really do not want our first interaction with you to be about your child's uniform, so do please familiarise yourself with the uniform guidelines and contact us in advance if you are having difficulty with sourcing uniform. Staff will check that students have completed their holiday homework on their first day. Students who have completed their homework will receive positive £HSAEL, with a rewards event planned for all students who pass their termly knowledge checks. Students who have not completed their homework will not enter circulation until this has been completed. We are opening the Academy on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> January so students can get extra support with their homework. Please encourage your child to attend if you know they may find the return to school-routines more challenging.

### Pastoral Updates for the spring term

We will continue to support students to develop the habits required to be successful at school: good attendance and punctuality, a positive behaviour pay check, regular homework completion and attendance at clubs. To support students who did not secure their bronze 'excellence' badge in the autumn, we will be re-allocating tutor groups so that students who need more support receive this. Please find below the list of tutor groups for the spring term. Students in the 'Science Academy'

tutor group will receive extra support to receive their **spring 'growth' badge**. Once they have received this badge, they will return to either the 'Clock Mill' or 'Lock Keepers' tutor group.

Following student feedback, we will be upgrading our expectations regarding transitioning around the site to ensure that lesson transitions reflect the same high standards as lessons. Students will receive a full induction to these expectations on the first day back.

### **Academic Updates for the Spring term**

### **Golden Nuggets & Winter Home Learning**

Our Golden Nugget project resumes in January giving HSAEL students to chance to prove they have secured their autumn term learning!

At HSAEL, our Golden Nugget Project ensures every student makes progress in their learning and no student gets left behind. This is why, at the start of every term, students take their Golden Nugget tests, which assess the most important terms they learnt the previous term.

Students were given their Spring Knowledge Booklet and new exercise book at line up in the last week of term. Over the break, they must ensure they take time to rest, relax and spend time with family however, before the return to school, it is important students prepare for these consolidation tests.

**Home Learning task:** Students must select five terms they do not know or do not feel confident with and complete one page of LCWC for five terms in every subject to prove they have revised. Remember- these are all terms students have studied in autumn so this will be a revision exercise for students.

Students may complete additional LCWC for HSAEL £ and extra revision to ensure they have achieved the 80% pass mark in all but one of their subjects in order to receive their Golden Ticket to attend the Knowledge Celebration in January. Students who do not receive this pass mark will be given targeted intervention to help them secure the knowledge and move onto their next term of learning.

In Autumn term, over 250 students made this accomplishment. We hope even more will meet our mark this time ready!

### DPR

We are very excited that our new homework platform has been well received by students. Our mission control shows almost every student logging into the platform to organise their time and their studies every day.

In the Autumn term, we also began using the platform in lessons to track student learning against pre-planned Key Objectives. HSAEL teachers are regularly using DPR to assess student learning as developing, consolidating or secured. The platform will be rolled out with parent this term so please look out for invites for our DPR Parent Launch.

The platform does not have an app but can be accessed on a web browser. It is called <u>Dynamic Progress Reporting</u> and is used by some of the highest performing schools in Newham.

### **Character Education updates for the autumn term**

At HSAEL, for children to become leaders in their chosen field, they will need much more than good exam results. Their qualifications will get them to the door of great opportunities, but the skills and experiences they accrue throughout their adolescence will mean they can have a positive change on their life and their community. Based on feedback from students and parents we have further developed our Character Education programme for Spring 2025.
